Exhibitors will be called into the building by CKC Stewards in small groups. Groups of 8 to 10 dogs will complete their first test. A brief rest, exhibitors will start the second test with the second evaluator. This will continue until tests complete.

**Ribbons:** Each dog who successfully passes the test will receive a qualifying ribbon. Dogs completing 2 successful tests will receive a title rosette

**Dog Eligibility:** Dogs who are at least 1 year of age are eligible to take the ATT and must either be AKC or FSS registered or listed with Canine Partners or have a Purebred Alternative Listing number. Dogs that are spayed or neutered may participate. Dogs must be able to perform whole categories of the test (such as hearing auditory stimuli and seeing visual stimuli), in order to be eligible to earn an ATT title. Dogs with disabilities such as those

that are blind, deaf, or have three legs are eligible to enter provided in the opinion of the evaluator they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the test. However, if a dog has multiple disabilities such that, it is unable to complete whole categories of the test (i.e. - hearing auditory stimuli and seeing visual stimuli), the dog would not earn the ATT title.

Bitches in season ARE allowed to enter.

**Entry Limits/Waiting List/Multiple Dogs:** There will be an entry limit of 25 dogs per test. Once entry limits have been met a 10 dog wait list for each test will be maintained. Handlers are eligible to test multiple dogs in a test. Entries will be accepted on a first come basis, until entry limit is reached or until September 6<sup>th</sup> when entries close.

**Notice to Exhibitors**

**Safety, Behavior and Liability:**

**Collars, Leashes and Harnesses.** Dogs may wear slip collars that are on a dead ring, buckle collars, martingales and body harnesses in the ATT. They may not wear prong collars, head collars, e-collars, or harnesses that restrict the movement of the dog. Leashes should be 4 ft or 6ft long and should be made of fabric or leather.

When exercising your dog(s) please clean up after them! Dispose of 'poop' bags in the trash containers provided outside the building (green dumpster).

**It is expressly understood** that all owners/agents/exhibitors are solely responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any person(s) whose dog(s) and/or children create

unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases no refund of any fees paid will be made. Cudahy Kennel Club and their agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. The Cudahy Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Cudahy Kennel Club or any official thereof.

**Refunds and Fees:** These trials may be cancelled in the event of extreme weather conditions. **No refunds** will be given if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, extreme or dangerous weather conditions, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other reason beyond the control of the organizing committee.

**Entry fees:** Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

**Errors on Entries:** Owners are responsible for the accuracy of the information required on the entry form. **Changes, additions, or corrections to an entry, entry substitutions or cancellations, must be received by the Trial Secretary, in writing or via e-mail, prior to the closing date of the trial.**

**Judging:** Neither the Trial Secretary nor any other individual is obligated to call or notify exhibitors when they are due in the ring for judging. Judges are not required to wait for any exhibitor. Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

**Show Site:** CKC reserves the right to remove any dog in distress in a parked vehicle or crate.

**Concessions:** Due to infection control measures no food or beverages will be available to entrants. Fast food restaurants are located near-by.

### **Infection Control Measures- IMPORTANT!!**

**Masks are required** while in building for those who are not vaccinated. Those individuals that are vaccinated do not need to wear a mask. Masks will be available for purchase at check in area.

Participants are required to perform **hand hygiene upon entry to the building**. Hand sanitizer will be available in multiple locations.

Participants or volunteers with signs of infection such as fever, chills, new onset cough/shortness of breath, sudden loss of taste or smell, **must not attend**.

Participants who have been in contact with someone with a COVID infection within the last 14 days must **not attend**.

Participants who have had been diagnosed with COVID in the last 14 days **should not attend until** a negative test is obtained or they are symptom free for 14 days.

There will be ONE Entrance and ONE Exit in the building.

**All Exhibitor crating will take place in your vehicle.**

Only a limited number of competitors will be allowed in the building at one time.

Only CKC Committee members who are both volunteering for the trial and participating in the Tests may crate in the building.

Social distancing for people and dogs must be maintained in the parking lot, self-check in and awards table areas at all times. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.

High-touch surfaces in building will be disinfected routinely throughout the day.

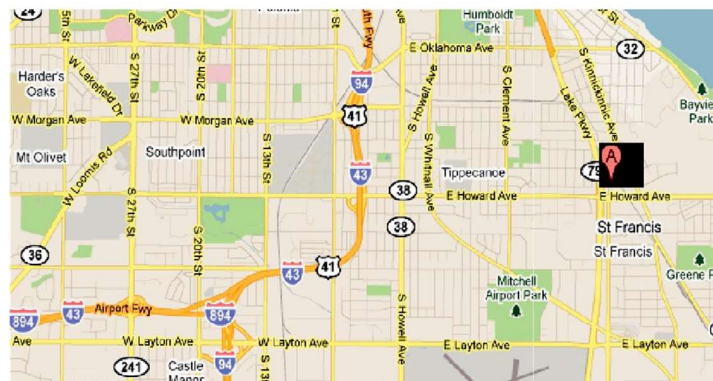
Additional infection control measures may be identified and will be included in judging programs emailed to participants prior to the trials.
