DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC

Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Females in season may not participate

Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Barb Budny at tuggersmom@sbcglobal.net. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.

The trial secretary will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The **safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all tasks safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the

discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the American Kennel Club or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During testing, dogs must wear a properly flat properly fitted collar. The leash shall be 4-6 feet in length. No prong collars or flex-leashes allowed on the farm.

All dogs must be on leash at all times unless confined to a crate, kennel or vehicle.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the testing area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: After closing date and prior to the testing, exhibitors will receive an email with information related to time gates open, parking rules etc.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations." Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements; for example, proof of rabies vaccination.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial Site. The testing site is a private farm. Please follow the directions that will be sent to the exhibitors. Please treat the trial area with respect, clean up after your self and your dogs. **THERE IS NO SMOKING ALLOWED AT THE TESTING SITE.**

Crating: All crating will be done outside or in your vehicle.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

No overnight parking of any vehicles will be allowed!

BITCHES IN SEASON. Bitches who come in season after the closing date will have the entry fee refunded.

RIBBONS

Each dog that qualifies will receive a "Q" ribbon.
Dogs obtaining their title will receive a new title ribbon.
