All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included and signed. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$35 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging.

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CKC is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Judging schedules will be sent after closing. If no email address is provided, they will be sent via first class mail to the address provided on the Official AKC Entry Form, after the closing date.

Mixed Breed Dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Breed should be marked as "All American Dog".

No dogs will be allowed onto the club grounds except those properly entered.

PLEASE NOTE: IF ENTRY IS SENT VIA NEXT DAY AIR SERVICE (UPS), AIRBORNE EXPRESS, FEDERAL EXPRESS, EXPRESS MAIL, ETC. MUST HAVE THE ACCEPTANCE SIGNATURE WAIVED.

Notice to Exhibitors

Safety, Behavior and Liability:

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely. All dogs must be held on a leash or confined to a crate in your car except when in the ring for judging. Dogs must be on a leash when being exercised, trained or when warming up. No flexi retracting leads are allowed. When exercising your dog(s) please clean up after them! Dispose of 'poop' bags in the trash containers provided outside the building (green dumpster).

It is expressly understood that all owners/agents/exhibitors are solely responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any person(s) whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases no refund of any fees paid will be made. Cudahy Kennel Club and their agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. The Cudahy Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Cudahy Kennel Club or any official thereof.

Refunds and Fees: These trials may be cancelled in the event of extreme weather conditions. **No refunds** will be given if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, extreme or dangerous weather conditions, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other reason beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Fees included in the entry fee: Obedience Trial recording fees are \$0.50 per first entry of each dog and Event Service Fees are \$3.00 per entry (not per dog). Rally Trial recording fees are \$3.50 per first entry of each dog and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

Refunds for Injured Dogs/Bitches In Season: Bitches in season will not be admitted to the Trial and are not permitted to compete. Entry fees for bitches in season or a dog that is injured after the closing date will be refunded (minus \$5.00 per day administration fee) if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary 30 minutes prior to the start of judging on April 17, 2021.

Jump Height: All classes requiring jumps will be judged in jump height order. Ascending order will be used on Saturday and Sunday. **If you are entering any of these classes, jump height is a required part of your entry.** Please refer to **AKC Obedience and Rally Regulations** for the description of classes, eligibility, and proper jump heights.

Errors on Entries: Owners are responsible for the accuracy of the information required on the entry form. **Changes, additions, or corrections to an entry, entry substitutions or cancellations, must be received by the Trial Secretary, in writing or via e-mail, prior to the closing date of the trial.**

Transfers (move-ups): Transfers for dogs that have completed the requirements for a title after the closing date will be accepted. The request must be in writing to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Forms will be available at the Trial Secretary's table.

Judging: Neither the Trial Secretary nor any other individual is obligated to call or notify exhibitors when they are due in the ring for judging. Judges are not required to wait for any exhibitor. Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Show Site: The two rings for these trials will be approximately 40' x 50' and 38' x 45' each, on cushioned matting. **CKC reserves the right to remove any dog in distress in a parked vehicle or crate.**

Concessions: Due to infection control measures no food or beverages will be available to entrants. Fast food restaurants are located near-by.

Catalogs: Trial catalogs are available **by advanced sale** for \$5.00. Please indicate the payment on your entry form and include the fee. A limited number of catalogs will be sold at the trial.

Infection Control Measures- IMPORTANT!!

Unless you are fully vaccinated masks covering the nose and mouth are required while in building or if the judge requests that competitors are masked in that judge's ring.

Participants or volunteers with signs of infection such as fever, chills, new onset cough/shortness of breath, sudden loss of taste or smell, **must not attend.**

Participants who have been in contact with someone with a COVID infection within the last 14 days must **not attend.** Participants who have had been diagnosed with COVID in the last 14 days **should not attend until** a negative test is obtained or they are symptom free for 14 days.

Classes will be scheduled throughout the day to help keep the numbers in the building to a minimum. Times will be determined once entries are received.

Cones will be used for figure 8 posts.

There will be a self-check-in station set up. Arm bands will be ready according to the class schedule. These times will be included on your judging program. Please bring your own pen for the check-in process.

Awards will be mailed to your home as a preferred method to enable participants to leave the site after their runs. Awards will also be available on an awards table separate from the self-check-in table.

There will be LIMITED Exhibitor crating in the building.

Only a limited number of competitors will be allowed in the building at one time.

Social distancing for people and dogs must be maintained at the self-check in and awards table areas and near the rings at all times. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.

High-touch surfaces in building will be disinfected routinely throughout the day.

Additional infection control measures may be identified and will be included in judging programs emailed to participants prior to the trials.

• **From the North:** Take 43 South to 94 East to 794 South to Howard Ave exit. Left 1 block to Pennsylvania Ave. Left on Pennsylvania Ave. 1 block to Cudahy Kennel Club on the right.

• **From the South:** Take 94 West (head North) to Howard Ave. Exit right on Howard Ave. and continue until Pennsylvania Ave. Turn Left on Pennsylvania, Go 1 block to Cudahy Kennel Club on the right.

• **From West:** 94 East to 794 South to Howard Ave exit. Left 1 block to Pennsylvania Ave. Left on Pennsylvania Ave. 1 block to Cudahy Kennel Club on the right.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
