Entries open November 6, 2023 and will close December 27, 2023 or when the limit is reached. Day of show entries accepted until the maximum run value for each judge/ring is met for that day. Any Judges of Record at this event may be used in any ring. Qualifying scores will show the Judge who designed the Course.

Classes offered: Saturday and Sunday: two (2) Trials each day. Trial 1 on each day will offer Instinct, Novice, Open, Senior, and Masters, and Crazy 8's. Trial 2 will offer Novice through Master. A tentative breakdown and run order will be listed in the confirmation. There will be a general briefing at 7:45 each morning. First blind will load at 8am. Blinds are located inside the building, all blinds will have 5 or 6 dogs. Novice and Open may have 6 dogs per blind depending on entries. Blinds are tents, 20 x 10. Judge's dogs will be run prior to the official start time of the Event. Judges are limited to 8 hours of judging and a maximum run value of 260 which will require the Club to limit entries accordingly.

START TIME: 1st dog on the line at 8:00am

General briefing at 7:45, parking lot/building open at 7:00am

This running order is subject to change depending on the entry numbers.

Further scheduling details will be emailed to all competitors after the trial closes and the actual number of entries in each class is known. We reserve the right to change the run order based on entries. Dogs will not run in any particular height order. Multiple dogs being handled by the same person will be separated into different blinds. All dogs are expected to compete in each class with the same general conditions; no special considerations will be made. Barn Hunt does not cater to aggressive/reactive dogs. All dogs and handlers in Barn Hunt have a right and expectation to safety without the need for special and extraordinary measures.

Entry fees: Instinct \$15, Novice \$22, Open \$22, Senior \$27, Master \$27, Crazy 8's \$25.

Late fee/day of entry fee adds \$5 per dog per run to be valid: All entries must be accompanied by entry fees (cash or check), include the BHA registration number, a completed registration form, and the signed release form. *A returned check does not constitute a valid entry and will be issued a \$50.00 fee.*

No entries will be taken over the phone. If you plan to enter after the closing deadline and/or day of, please email the trial secretary ahead of time as a courtesy. Day of show entries **must be paid in cash** with exact change and will be taken from 7am-7:30am each day. Move ups available all weekend: must be made at the secretary table immediately following the qualifying run.

Late and/or Day of Show entries are not guaranteed entry and will be accepted only up to judging limits. Confirmations may not be sent for late entries.

All dogs must be on a short leash and under control while on trial grounds except while showing. FLEXI LEASHES ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE GROUNDS OR INSIDE THE BUILDING. Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers.

The trial will be held indoors on mats. There is indoor crating space available! These trials take both PRE-ENTRY and Day of Show entries (if we do not fill) Day of show entries are limited to 30 minutes prior to the briefing each day.

There will be a lunch break at the committee/judge discretion. Food/snacks will be provided for the workers. The club will NOT have food for sale. There are fast food restaurants within a short drive.

This is a Trial and is open to all Breeds and Mixed Breeds of all sizes!

This trial will be held INDOORS. The building is heated.

Rings have a matted surface. Crating will be allowed inside.

Smoking and/or vaping are not allowed in the buildings or on the show grounds. Bitches in season are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run at the end of their class/trial. We will designate a BIS crating area. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial secretary prior to the trial and inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing. Bitches in Season will be run in a separate blind at the end of class entered. ***Remember your dog must wear panties at all times at the show site (except when being taken out to potty.)*** We will direct you to your crating and potty area, please come to the secretary's table before unloading your dog. Thank you! Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until closing date of the trial if you wish to withdraw. After the trial closes, entry fees will not be refunded. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

Dogs may be entered in BOTH the Instinct class and Novice class in the same trial until the dog has earned the RATN title, after which time they may no longer enter the Instinct class. Dogs earning a title in Trial 1 on Saturday/Sunday may be moved up to the next class for Trial 2. This is up to the handler and not required. Move-up forms will be available at the Trial Secretary's table.

Move ups/downs/lateral will be accepted day to day and trial to trial.

REFUNDS: No refunds will be made after the entry deadline. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the Trial Committee.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for all qualifiers in all classes. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st-4th place in each height division of the A & B classes. A High In Class Award will be offered in each A and Master B Class. Title Ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a title.

Additional Important Information

Exhibitors are responsible for being ready to go to the staging area, in the staging area, and waiting for the call to the gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. The club has no obligation or responsibility for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

*Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors.
(Always check your confirmation!)*

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so WILL be fined and may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Wait List: If we fill, we will maintain a wait list. If an entry is withdrawn after the closing date and we have dogs on the waitlist who are able to take your spot, ONLY then will you receive a refund.
